The Elizabeth Fry Society of Greater Vancouver (EFry) is a charitable organization that supports women, girls, and children at risk, involved in or affected by the justice system. Our programs work to break the cycle of poverty, addiction, mental illness, homelessness, and crime.

We are recruiting for a part time, Clinical Counsellor (Substance Use) for our Firth Residence. Located in Abbotsford, the Firth program provides bed-based stabilization and support for women with substance use concerns. Women participate in the program for 3-5 months, with a self-identified goal of abstinence from substance use. Support workers are responsible for case planning, group facilitation, linkage with community resources, transition planning, and the day to day running of the facility. The Clinical Counsellor provides individual, short-term, counselling support to clients.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Interview clients to gather case history information.
- Develop and implement therapeutic plans and programs necessary to meet client goals and objectives.
- Provide individual counselling interventions to address identified plans for substance use and concurrent disorders. May use specific therapeutic techniques depending on client type e.g., psychoeducation, CBT, DBT, motivational enhancement.
- Work with team to ensure service plan goals are met.
- Liaise with substance use and mental health professionals in the community.
- Ensure all required documentation is accurate and complete.
- Maintain strict confidentiality of information.
- Maintain knowledge of community resources and provide appropriate referrals to clients to meet their needs.
- Participate in staff training sessions and public education forums, seminars, and conferences relevant to specific program areas.
- Participate in individual and group clinical supervision monthly or as needed. Engage in ongoing professional development.

MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS:

- Registration with a regulatory or professional organization (e.g. BCACC, BCCSW).
- Master's Degree in a related discipline such as clinical counselling, clinical psychology, or social work.

- At least two year's relevant work experience.
- Standard First Aid with CPR-C.
- COVID19 vaccinated status.
- Evidence of a Tuberculosis Test and compliance with the TB Control Program.
- Doctor's Note of fitness required.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Review (Vulnerable Sector Search).

QUALIFIED CANDIDATES WILL ALSO POSSESS:

- Direct program delivery experience in the community social services sector with a demonstrated working knowledge of community-based programs and related provincial and community support services systems is preferred.
- Proficient in Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT), motivational enhancement, and evidence-based interventions.
- Knowledge of theories and best practice related to substance use.
- Experience working with vulnerable populations.
- Excellent communication skills both written and verbal.
- Valid driver's license (Class 5) and satisfactory driving record an asset.
